Remote Learning for Students Self-Isolating

In order to bring remote learning more in line with other schools in the Trinity MAT, we are changing the way that we provide work for students who are required to self-isolate and therefore learn remotely.

Students who require learning at home will no longer attend 'live lessons' with their teachers, but will instead access Trinity TV – a collection of pre-recorded video lessons that support the schemes of learning that students would be following in school. This has a number of benefits: students can access lessons at a pace and time that suits them and their families at home; the videos are more visually engaging than a blank screen and it offers the flexibility to allow for screen breaks when needed.

These video lessons have been developed by our colleagues at Trinity Academy Halifax, and have been used throughout the most recent lockdown by students there. Students should watch the videos, pausing at the points where staff instruct them to, and complete their work on either paper or a digital device, whichever their preference. The videos may reference Microsoft Forms. This is a technology that we have been unable to set up yet. If students would like to share their work with their teachers, can they please use their teachers' email address.

Students who need to learn remotely will be added into a Microsoft Team for their year group. In here are all the resources they need to access their lessons in all subjects, initially for 10 days (the recommended period of self-isolation). Their Student Support Officer and a member of the Senior Leadership Group will be monitoring these Teams daily in order to respond to any queries students should have. Please contact the school if your child will require more than 10 days learning.

We are moving towards having a digital platform where students can access the relevant video for exactly the lesson in the scheme of learning that they would have been studying in school that day. This will be developed over the next term.
