### **Trinity Challenge 2023**

### How does Trinity Challenge 2023 work?

As an academy, we challenge our students to take part in the Trinity Challenge. This involves participation in a range of tasks from the following areas:

- The Arts, Culture and Performance
- STEM
- Earthshot
- Wellbeing and Aspirations
- The Community

In addition, these challenges have been put into four DofE categories to support tracking of students progress towards the DofE Bronze Award.

We will support students to achieve the Trinity Challenge award by providing opportunities within the academy through the curriculum, Involve club opportunities and academy trips throughout Year 9. Other challenges require students to go the extra mile and complete tasks outside of the academy. This can be independently or with friends or family.

The evidence for completion of these challenges will be tracked and recorded by form tutors, the Admin team in the academy, through attendance at certain events or from students bringing in evidence of completing the tasks during form time. This evidence can also be emailed to form tutors in the form of a photo or video. Alternatively, students may just wish to describe how they completed the tasks and the new skills they have developed in doing so.

An essential basic skill. Make sure you have some advice from an adult in your home before completing this task.

Evidence: The evidence will be tracked during form with your Form Tutor.

#### TC11: Attend an academy sports / dance / PA club

Please note to achieve the DofE Bronze award you will need to complete 15 of the skills challenges over a 6 - 9 month period. All the blue skills are 'Life skills' and so students could complete a range of these to meet the requirements for the Skills section.
