Dear Parent/Carer

We are writing to inform you of some upcoming developments here at the academy that will impact our usual operations. Starting from **27 June 2024**, construction work will commence on our new building. This is an exciting phase for us as it marks progress towards enhancing our facilities for the benefit of all students and staff.

In preparation for the construction work, building contractors will be preparing large sections of the academy site. This is necessary to ensure the safety of everyone present on the premises during the construction period, however, current entrance and exits points will remain unchanged up to the summer break.

September 2024

From 3 September 2024, there will be no access to the car park for parents/carers, visitors or taxis due to the restrictions the construction team will have in place, the school bus will continue to access the academy grounds. We understand that this may cause inconvenience for some of you, especially during drop-off and pick-up times. To mitigate any potential disruption, we advise all parents to utilise the overflow car park adjacent to the main site for drop-offs and collections. Please be aware that part of this will also be utilised by the construction team throughout the day.

Additionally, parents/carers with car parking passes will no longer be able to enter the academy grounds due to the ongoing construction work, this will be reviewed as the construction work develops and we will make changes throughout the journey of the build. We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause and appreciate your cooperation as we work to ensure the safety and smooth functioning of the academy during this period of transformation.

To be considerate of our residents, we kindly ask that parents refrain from parking on the road immediately outside of the academy or on local side streets. This will help alleviate congestion and ensure the safety and convenience of all community members.

From September, all students and visitors will access the academy via the pathway to the left of the former premises building on Deanstones Lane. Academy staff will be present at the start and end of the academy day to direct students and ensure their safety.

We understand that changes like these can sometimes be challenging, but please be assured that we are committed to minimising any disruption to your child's education and overall experience at the academy.
