## **Notice of Concrete Power Floating Works**

We are writing to inform you of upcoming construction activities related to concrete power floating as part of our ongoing Trinity Academy project. These works are essential to ensure the highest quality and durability of the concrete surfaces being installed.

## Scheduled Dates of these works.

- Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> January
- Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> January
- Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> January
- Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> January
- Monday 27<sup>th</sup> January
- Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> January

Due to the nature of the power floating process, these works will continue into the early hours of the morning. Power floating must be performed during a specific window when concrete is curing to achieve the necessary strength and finish.

## Noise Mitigation Measures.

We understand that this may cause some inconvenience and have taken the following steps to reduce the impact on resdients.

- Using modern equipment designed to minimize noise levels.
- Ensuring all work is carried out as efficiently and quietly as possible.
- The work areas will be sheeted off with acoustic sheeting to reduce noise.
- Required task lighting will be installed to face the school and not Deanstones Lane.
- There will be no deliveries or operated plant used after 6pm.
- We will have full management present on site during the power floating shifts.

We sincerely apologize for any disruption this may cause and thank you for your patience and understanding as we complete these critical works.

Should our plans change due to weather, we will notify via another letter.
